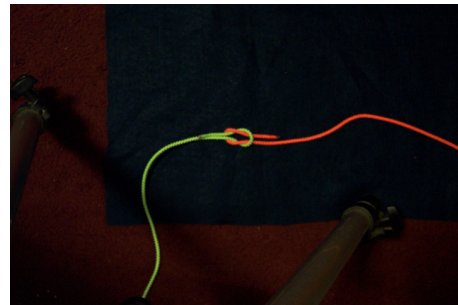
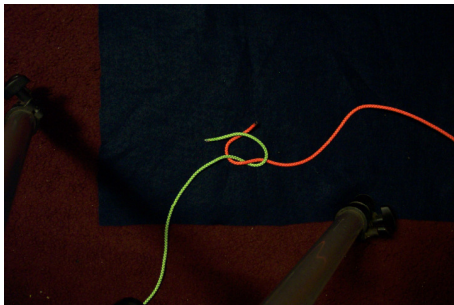
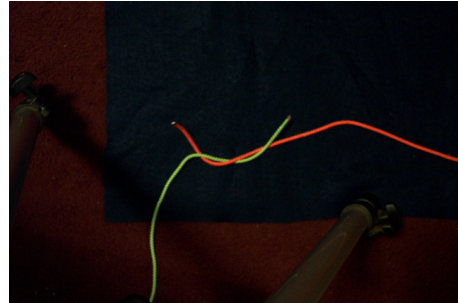
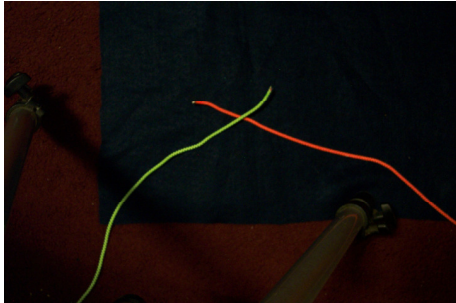


Square Knot



The Square knot is used to join ropes of the same size together. This knot is easy to learn and easy to tie, it is also easy to untie. The ease with which the square knot can be untied can be a problem.

To tie the knot (as shown above) put the green over the orange and then wrap under the orange. Again put the green over the orange and then under the orange so that the orange and green lines now lie next to each other. If the two lines do not exit the other loop then you have made a mistake and need try again.

When you teach this it is much easier to have two different color lines so that you don't have to worry about your students knowing left from right.
